Submit application on 8.5 x 11 paper, typed (12 point font, single spaced), or printed. 1. List goals and knowledge gained of your dairy goat project (years completed, herd size, skills gained, etc.)
2. Chart an estimate of profit or loss incurred for each year of your goat project.
3. List dairy goat related awards, demonstrations, public service, and group activities (4-H, FFA, other)
4. List leadership experiences designed to aid others involved in dairy goats.
5. List activities, community service, and awards you received NOT related to dairy goats.
6. Write a double-spaced essay (12 point font, maximum 6 pages) describing your dairy goat project. Discuss how and why you chose dairy goats, knowledge and experiences gained, and future plans.
7. College or high school year (specify) and current cumulative GPA.
